Hybrid begins – Week of Oct. 26

Half of all students on campus each day

- Mon. 10/26: 1/2/3/7 (A-K)
- Tue. 10/27: 4/5/6/0 (A-K)
- Wed. 10/28: Flex Day (Spotlight: 11th)
- Thu. 10/29: 1/2/3/7 (L-Z)
- Fri. 10/30: 4/5/6/0 (L-Z)



Role of Families

- Encourage your student to stay at home if sick, exposed, or if a household member is sick
- Comply with County health & safety measures
- Help facilitate temperature checks with your daughter before school and ensure that she is filling out her CHS Prescreen App
- Wear a mask whenever outside your home, including during carpooling



Role of Families



- Avoid large gatherings
- Avoid unessential travel; if you travel we strongly recommend staying home the following week and getting tested
- Wash your hands frequently
- Get tested if you are concerned about symptoms or exposure
- Communicate if you have questions or concerns

Health & Safety Measures

Face Coverings

- Masks must be worn at all times after leaving your car or when carpooling with others
- When eating or hydrating, stay physically distanced
- Students encouraged to carry a back-up mask; extras available on campus



Hand Hygiene

- Frequent hand washing encouraged
- Hand sanitizer available in classrooms and event spaces
- Avoid touching face, mouth, nose, and eyes

Health & Safety Measures



Physical Distancing

- Reduced classroom capacity by 50%
- 6 feet of separation between seats
- Excess furniture removed from common areas
- Plexiglass shields added to teacher desks, offices, library, reception, and more
- Signage, floor stickers, and social media reminders

Outdoor Spaces

- Created outdoor space for classes and work on balconies, amphitheater, and under covered garage



Health & Safety Measures

Facility Cleanliness


- All campus facilities cleaned daily according to CDC guidelines
- High-touch areas like restrooms, stair railings, and hydration stations disinfected multiple times daily
- Touchless hydration stations, paper towel machines, and soap dispensers
- Nightly disinfection



Community Safety

CHS Prescreen App

- Daily self-certification via app by students, faculty, and staff before arriving to campus
- Students will show their green "clear" screens to staff members at checkpoints each morning
- Additional temperature checks will be used on case-by-case basis



Community Safety

Before School

- Students should not arrive to campus before 7:45 AM
- Students will show their green "clear" screens to staff members at checkpoints each morning
- Students should head directly to their first classroom of the day

After School

- Students are expected to leave campus immediately after their last class, unless involved in pre-scheduled programming
